## **Recorder’s report**

14 residents have prepaid (in February) their street user fee dues for July which will reduce our July street user fee revenue coupled with those residents who do not pay their dues. Our reduced street user fee revenue will amount to \$4,000 so we need to watch our planned road repair expenses to allow for the shortfall in July.

Evans's construction breakdown:

Hauling, milling and paving for curbed roads - \$25 per linear foot

Hauling and paving for non-curbed roads - \$16 per linear foot

Hauling, milling and patching - \$7 per linear foot

Brown Asphalt breakdown:

Paving curbed roads - \$27.12 per lineal foot

Paving uncurbed roads - \$18 per lineal foot

Patching roadways - \$22.17 per sq. foot
