Council meeting minutes Final

February 13th, 2020

Minutes

Safety Report

Don Stemple gave a report on Taking Flood Warnings Seriously

If you are under a flood warning, find shelter right away.

- Do not walk, swim, or drive through flood waters. Turn around, don't drown.
- Stay off of bridges that are over fast-moving water
- Determine how best to protect yourself based on the type of flooding. Evacuate if told to do so.

Recorders Report

Received copies of annual summary and transmittal of US information returns.

Filled quarterly Federal tax for October, November and December of 2019

Received and signed audit extension request for 2018 audit from Ferarri and associates. Extended to June 30th, 2020.

The levy estimate budget is due between March 7th and the 28th.
