#### **DISCOVER NORTH HILLS RECREATION AREAS**

We are all aware how nice North Hills is for taking a walk. Most are aware, that in addition on the nice walks along Town streets, that we also have trails around the pond and back and forth from the pond parking lot to the pool parking lot. There is also a hidden gem of a trail system that starts at the pool parking lot and heads past the dog park and beyond. Unfortunately, these great trails have become almost unusable due to drainage issues that have built up the last few years.

The Council has approved correcting these drainage issues and the clearing of overgrowth. This will almost double the length of the trails and allow fields to be viable for future usage such as soccer fields, community garden, or other ideas. We are looking for your input. We will also need help to plant new trees and other landscaping ideas and assistance.

Council is also exploring the clearing the overgrowth on the non-paved section of Lake Drive to provide a trial that would connect with Brentwood Drive.
