Building Permits

We have enjoyed a busy few months of building permit applications. Unfortunately, not every resident has complied with this Town ordinance/law. A permit is required if construction is not for an in-kind replacement. If you're not sure a permit is required; please contact any Council member and we would be glad to discuss. Permits are easy to fill out and have a small nominal fee. Failure to get a permit may lead to penalties and even removal of constructed item(s). Permits are not intended to be restrictive but protective of your property value and maintain a level of consistency that made us choose North Hills. As a reminder; North Hills is not an HOA. North Hills is an incorporated Town in West Virginia. Council reserves the right to hold Municipal Court and level fines up to \$2000 per violation. Please help us avoid this, since it is expensive for you and the Town, by filling out a permit. Permits can be found on the Town website.
